“When we extend the circle of compassion to include all living things, we definitely find peace”, said Albert Schweitzer, a nobel peace prize winner for his work that made the “concept of brotherhood a living one”.

A German – French theologian, a medial missionary, an accomplished musician and a philosopher, Albert Schweitzer was clearly a man of many talents and purposes. However, he is best remembered today as a great humanitarian who worked to cure the sick in the jungles of Africa.

In 1904, at the age of twenty – nine, Schweitzer read an appeal from the French Protestant Missionary Society in Paris asking for help for the natives of French Equatorial Africa. In order to help his best, he resolved to become a doctor and dedicated the next seven years of his life to the study of medicine. Having qualified as a doctor of medicine, in 1913 he journeyed to Lambarene, a small village on the banks of the river Ogowe in West Africa and committed himself to help people and cure diseases.

At first he built huts or houses which were needed for the treatment of the sick and soon founded a hospital at Lambarene.

For his many years of humanitarian efforts Schweitzer was awarded the 1952 Nobel Peace prize. With the 33,000\$ prize money, he started a Leprosarium at Lambarere. His noble life and work is an inspiring message of compassion addressed to all of us on earth, regardless of our nationality or race.
